**Perpetrators aren't always easy to spot.
YOU can help by being vigilant and knowing
what to look for:**

- Bookings made in different names to those checking in
- Guests who requests rooms that are isolated
- Young male or female checking in with adults that don't appear to be family
- Guests insisting on paying in cash
- Adult person appears to have control over a young person or speaks for them
- Noise complaints
- Last minute/walk in bookings
- A young person who looks fearful, nervous, withdrawn or uncomfortable
- Young people loitering in the bar, reception or corridor areas
- Multiple adults and young people checking into the room
- Frequent visitors who do not appear to have a reason for being at the hotel
- Guests who are in and out of the hotel at odd times
