

# What you need to know:

- The design should have a festive theme ideas you could consider are kindness, friendship, your favourite thing about Christmas, favourite foods, favourite stories
- All entries need to include a completed entry form with name, age and full postal address on the back – full names will NOT be published
- The designs will be judged by a selection of our staff

### The details...

**Greeting:** We'll insert our own greeting, so only the front design is needed **Materials:** 

- The design should be drawn or painted on plain paper or produced electronically
- The e-card will be produced in full colour, so designs can be as colourful as you like
- All entries must be scanned or photographed, and emailed to us
- Materials such as cotton wool or glitter can't be reproduced
- Designs should be original avoid the use of stencils and stamps
- We won't be able to reproduce cartoon characters because of copyright issues

# The winning design will:

- Be used for the CELCIS Christmas e-card, which will be sent out in Scotland, the rest of the UK, and internationally
- Be identified by the first name of the entrant
- Only be used for the CELCIS e-card and its promotion, and should not be reproduced by any other organisations

#### Judging:

Entries will be judged on imagination, originality and creativity. The most skilled artist won't necessarily be the winner.
