 - Timelines

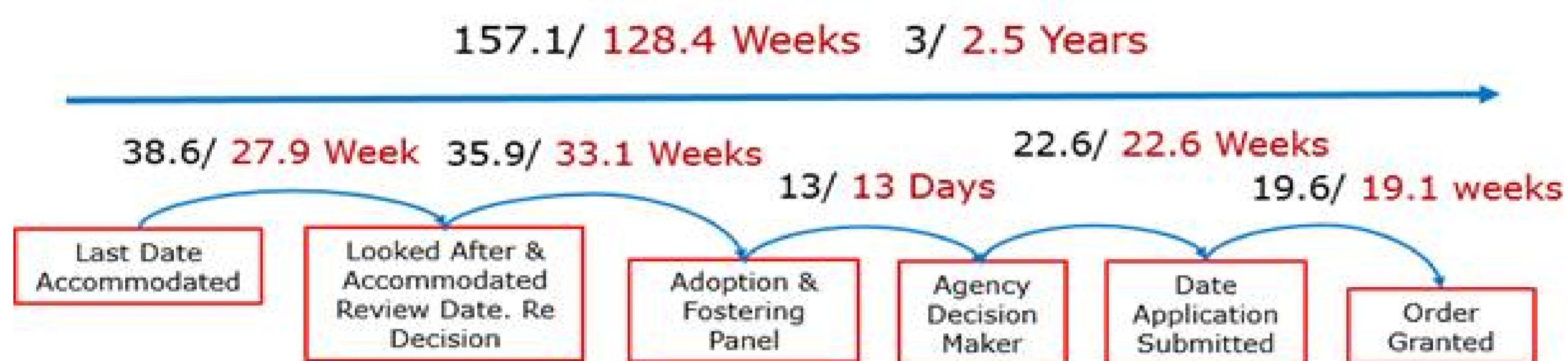

Key milestones for children/ young people who are looked after and become accommodated away from home:



WORK UNDERTAKEN IN THE LAST YEAR:

- Clarifying process map and the decision making processes
- Produced a permanence leaflet
- A new permanence recording form
- A focus on including and engaging frontline staff
- Focus on Kinship care
- Changing the language of permanence with workers & families
- Legal advice
- A new parenting capacity assessment framework
- RE-fresh permanence procedures

2018 - NEED TO START LOOKING AT THE WHOLE SYSTEM
4 Draft Aims

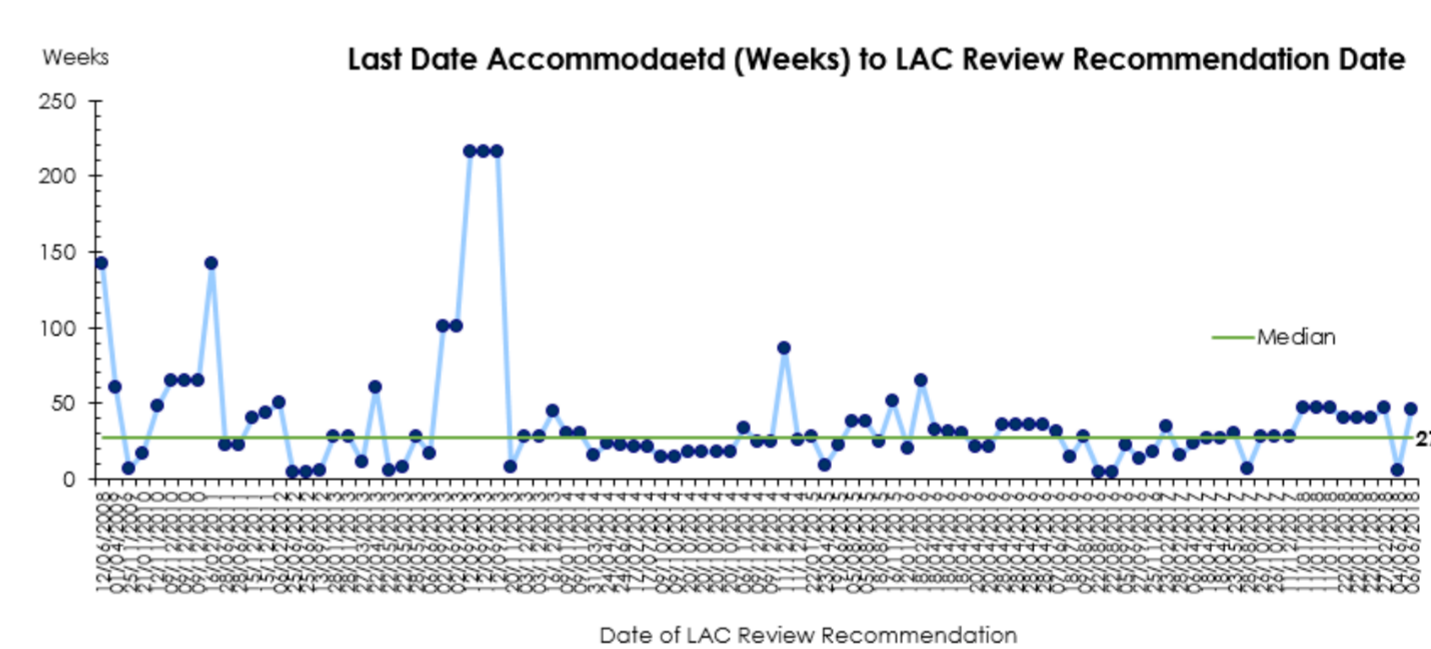
AIM 1
 Children who have been looked after at home for more than 2 years will have a 24 month review looking at their whole journey of being looked after at home on a CSO.

AIM 2
 Looked after & accommodated children will have a recommendation for permanence (including permanent return home) within 6 months of becoming looked after and accommodated.

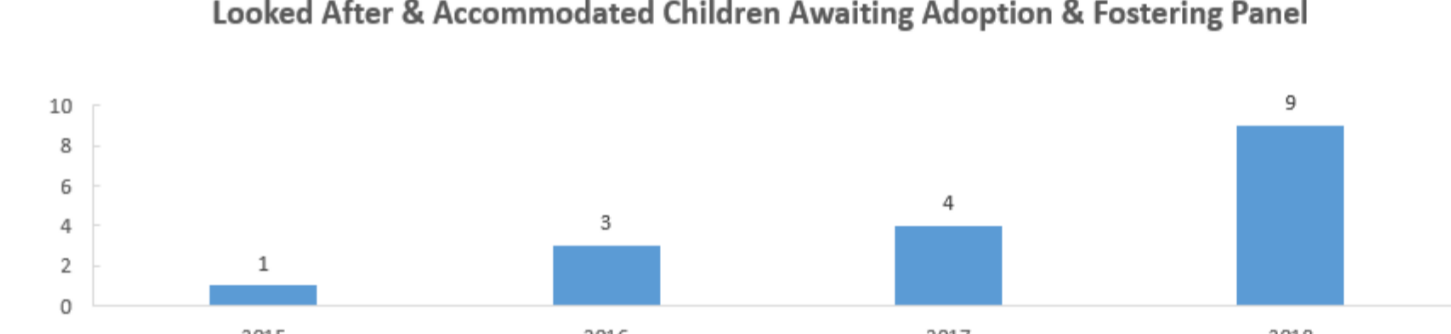
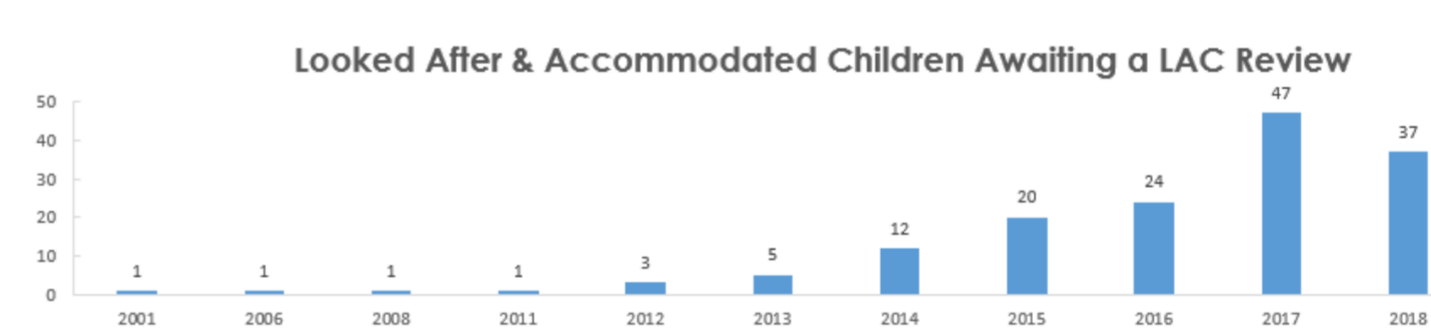
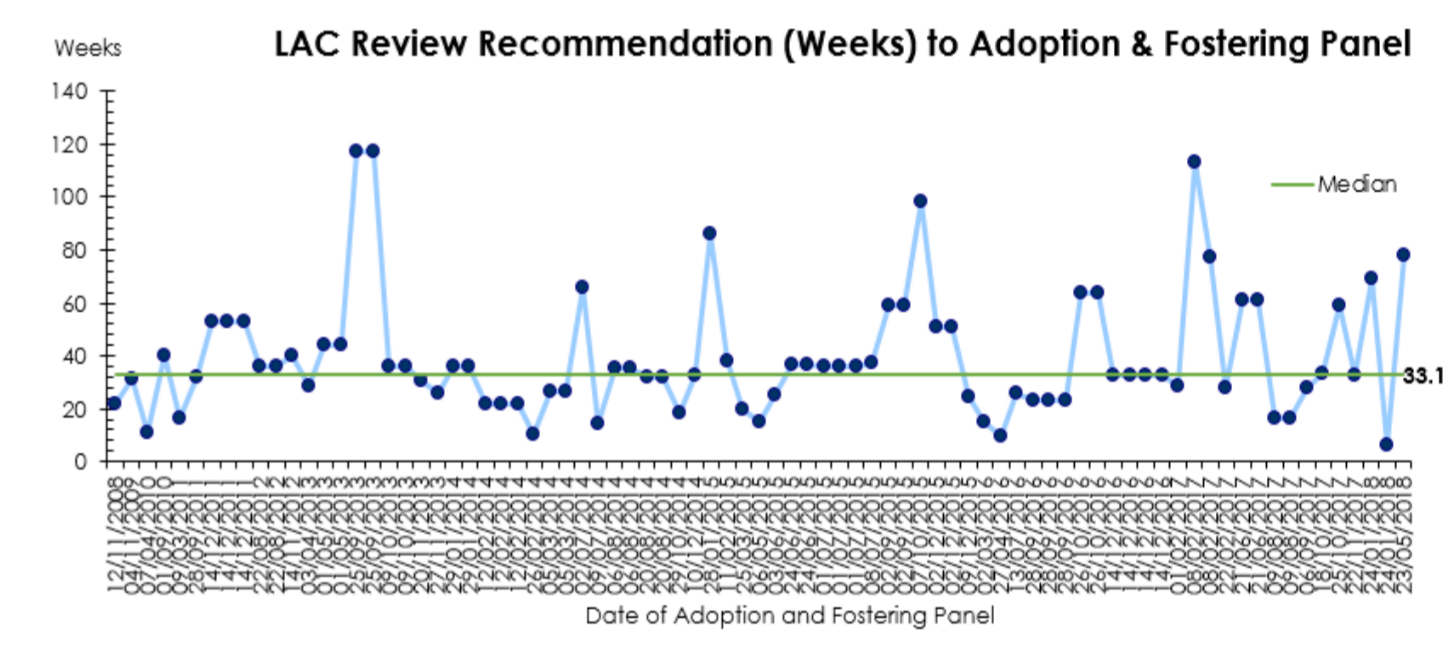
AIM 3
 Children with a recommendation for permanence away from home will have the decision ratified by the Agency Decision Maker within 14 weeks of the Looked After Review that recommended permanence.

AIM 4
 Children with a plan approved by the Agency Decision Maker will have their application for a legal order lodged within 3 weeks of Agency Decision Maker agreeing with the recommendation.

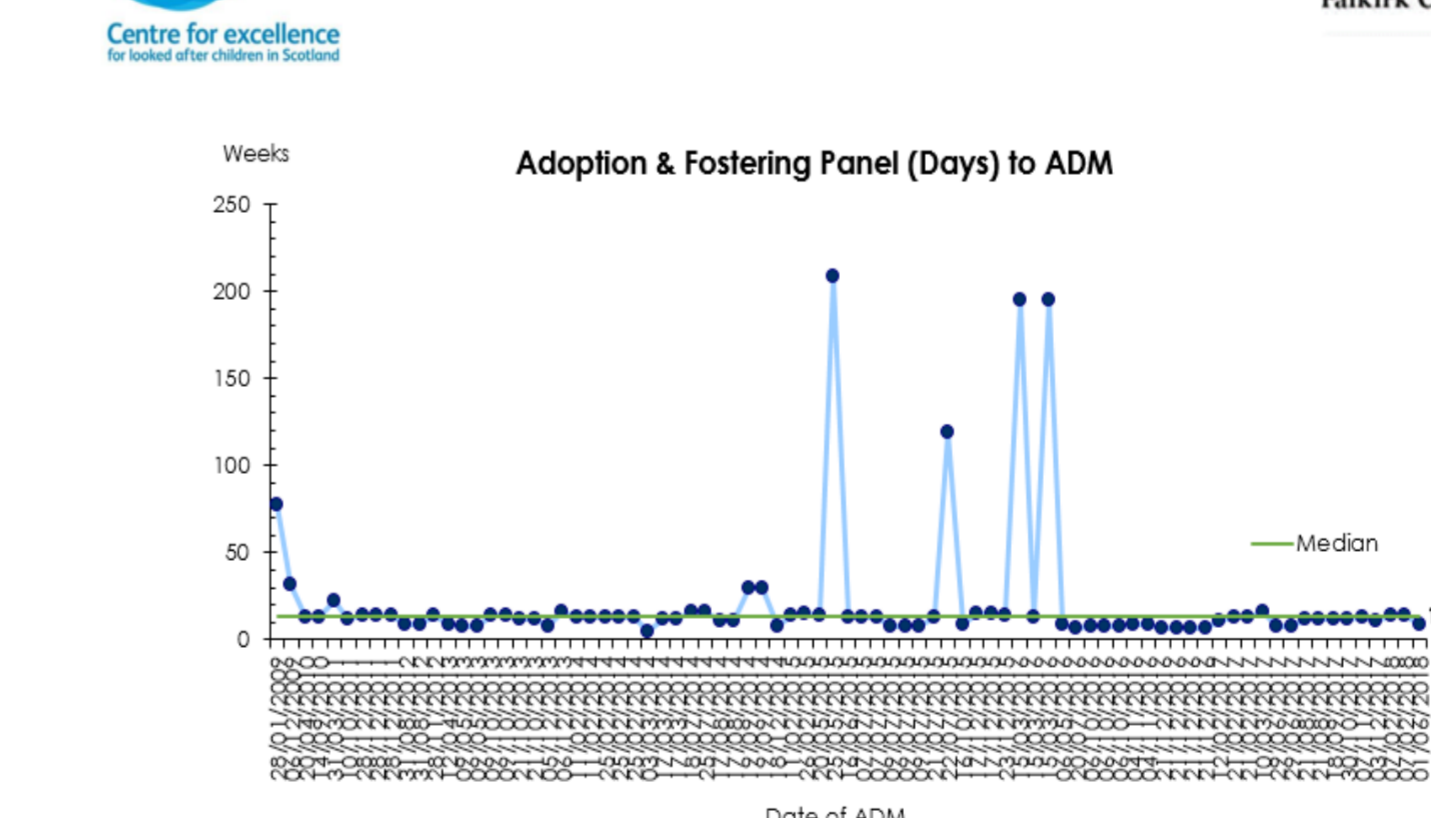

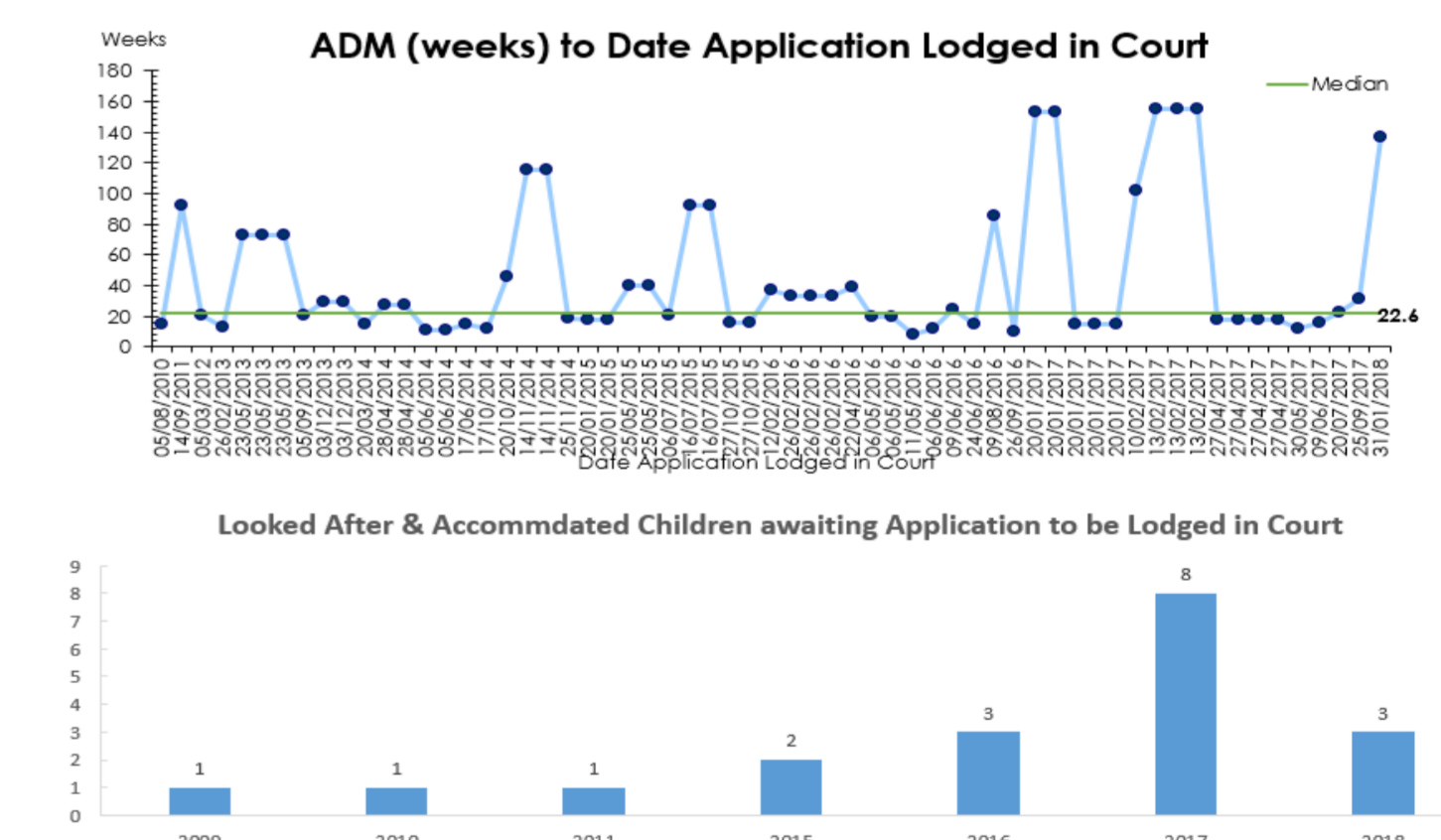
