**Perpetrators aren't always easy to spot.
YOU can help by being vigilant and knowing
what to look for:**

- Young person in the company of adults that don't appear to be family members
- Adults buying alcoholic drinks although the young person is already tipsy.
- Young people being bought food and drinks by older adult whom they seem to see as a boyfriend/girlfriend.
- Groups of young people being approached by older adults offering them cigarettes/alcohol/drugs
- Adult person appears to have control over a young person or speaks for them
- A young person looking fearful, nervous, withdrawn or uncomfortable
- A young person who seems to be incoherent or under the influence of alcohol
