## Poster guidelines

For SIRCC 2020, we also encourage the presentation of research, practice models or other relevant content that can be displayed as a poster throughout the duration of the conference.

Presenters will be encouraged to prepare a 5-minute overview of their poster during lunchtime both days of the conference. Accepted posters should follow the guidelines / information below:

1. The posters should be A0 (841 x 1189mm) in size and set out portrait-style.
2. All posters will be fixed to poster boards with Velcro fasteners so please don't use heavyweight paper as it will be difficult to hang.
3. All posters will be on display for the duration of the conference, with the presentation section during the first half hour of lunch each day.
4. All posters should clearly include the name, title and organisation of the presenter(s), as well as an email address if any of the conference delegates want to get in touch.
5. Your poster should be self-contained and self-explanatory; allowing delegates the ability to follow the information on their own.
6. For maximum impact, your poster should include captioned illustrations, photographs, graphs or other visually appealing materials. Use large type in short, separated paragraphs.

You can apply to present a poster using the 'Call for contributions application' on the conference website, detailing your presentation idea.
