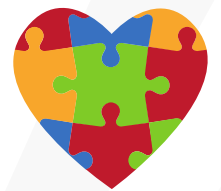


We want to celebrate the residential workers and teams who go the extra mile to inspire and improve the lives of young people in residential care. There are four award categories:

How to nominate a residential worker, team or practice

Who is eligible?

You can nominate any **current providers** of residential child care services in Scotland. For the Shining Stars category only one person within a local authority, voluntary or private organisation should nominate someone.

Information we'll need from you

We'll ask you to fill in the attached nomination form, which includes:

- The **name** of the practice, service or team you're nominating, including **all the organisations involved** for the Breaking Barriers Category and **each team member** for the Top Teams category
- **Permission** for us to **promote** the service or practice you're nominating from all those involved
- **Information to support your application** - e.g. video footage, photos or publication references

For the practice, service or team you're nominating, please tell us:

- **When** it was **developed**
- **Why** it was **developed**
- Why it's **needed**
- **Who** **benefits** from it
- **How it improves outcomes** for children and young people in residential child care
- If and how any **young people** were **involved** in shaping or delivering the service or practice and giving feedback
