Safe	Avoiding harm to children from care that is intended to help them.
Timely	Reducing waits and sometimes harmful delays.
Effective	Services based on evidence and produce a clear benefit.
Efficient	Avoiding waste in children's journeys through Care.
Child-centred	Establishing a partnership between practitioners and children and their families to ensure Care respects rights and preferences.
Equitable	Providing Care that does not vary in quality because of a child's characteristics.
